


Figure 1. Power Derating




Figure 3. Collector Saturation Region




Figure 5. Temperature Coefficients




Figure 6. Collector Cut-Off Region

Figure 2. DC Current Gain




Figure 7. Small-Signal Current Gain




Figure 8. Capacitance




Figure 9. Switching Times Test Circuit




Figure 10. Switching Times




Figure 11. Thermal Response




Figure 12. Maximum Forward Bias Safe Operating rea

There are two limitations on the power handling ability of a transistor: average junction temperature and second breakdown. Safe operating area curves indicate $I_C - V_{CE}$ limits of the transistor that must be observed for reliable operation; i.e., the transistor must not be subjected to greater dissipation than the curves indicate.

The data of Figure 12 is based on $T_{J(pk)} = 150^{\circ}\text{C}$; T_{C} is variable depending on conditions. Second breakdown pulse limits are valid for duty cycles to 10% provided $T_{J(pk)} < 150^{\circ}\text{C}$. $T_{J(pk)}$ may be calculated from the data in Figure 11. At high case temperatures, thermal limitations will reduce the power that can be handled to values less than the limitations imposed by second breakdown.




Figure 13. Darlington Schematic


