



Figure 5. On–Resistance Variation with Temperature

Figure 6. Drain-to-Source Leakage Current vs. Voltage



Figure 8. Gate-to-Source Voltage vs. Charge







Figure 9. Resistive Switching Time Variation vs. Gate Resistance

Figure 10. Diode Forward Voltage vs. Current






Figure 11. Safe Operating Area

Figure 12. I<sub>PEAK</sub> vs. Time in Avalanche





Figure 13. Thermal Characteristics


